We use communion Sundays as an opportunity to give an extra offering in gratitude for the Lord's grace and to support the church's missions and mercy ministries. There are boxes near the exits titled "mercy" for your opportunity to give.

The worship of the Triune God is the believer's most important duty. We are told in John 4:23-24 that God the Father is seeking those who will worship Him in spirit and truth. As you prepare for this worship service, purpose to be a participant, not a spectator. Join in the praise of the congregational singing; join in the joyful giving of tithes and offerings; pray along with the elders adding your "Amen" (signifying your agreement with the petition, confession of sin, or adoration); and carefully listen to God speaking through the preaching of His Word. May our Sovereign Lord receive glory today as you actively worship Him.
