¹ Although not written by the apostles, the Apostles' Creed is a concise summary of their teachings – the orthodox, Biblical faith. It originated as a baptismal confession in the second century and developed into its present form by the sixth or seventh century. In a culture that triumphs individualism, professions of faith underscore the corporate heritage and unity of our worship.

"What we need is not just intellectual theorizing, but a demonstration. One of the most powerful ways of turning people's loyalty to Jesus is by loving others with the great love of God. We cannot revive faith by argument alone, but we might catch the imagination of puzzled men and women by an exhibition of a fellowship and a redemptive purpose so intensely alive that every thoughtful person would be forced to respect it. If there should emerge in our day such a fellowship, wholly without artificiality, it would be an exciting event of momentous importance. A society of genuine, loving people, set free from the self-seeking struggle for personal prestige and from all unreality, onto a relentless service of God and his way, would be something unutterably priceless and powerful. A wise person would travel any distance to join it."
