Text: John 14:16-17, 25-26

Title: “Help From the Holy Spirit”

For most Christians, the third person of the Trinity is the least understood. We don't know how to think of Him or relate to Him. But Scripture presents the Holy Spirit as fully God — and as God's provision of Himself when we so desperately need help in our weakness!
